

TRAILER BILL OF SALE

1. 1. Seller and Buyer

TRAILER BILL OF SALE. Date of Sale: [DATE OF SALE]. The Seller represents being the lawful owner of the trailer described below and having full authority to sell it. Both parties confirm being of legal age to complete this transaction.

2. 2. Trailer Description

The Seller sells and transfers to the Buyer the following trailer (the "Trailer"): Year: [YEAR]. Make or manufacturer: [MAKE, or HOMEMADE / SHOP BUILT]. Model: [MODEL]. Type: [TYPE, e.g., open utility, enclosed cargo, car hauler, flatbed, dump, boat trailer, horse or livestock, gooseneck]. Color: [COLOR]. 3. 3. Axles, Weight Ratings, and Towing Equipment

4. 4. Purchase Price and Payment

5. 5. Title, Liens, and Untitled Trailers

The Seller warrants having clear title to the Trailer, free of all liens and encumbrances, except: [DISCLOSED LIEN OR NONE], and will deliver a written lien release within [LIEN RELEASE PERIOD, e.g., ten days] if a lien exists. Where the Trailer is titled in [STATE], the Seller will sign the certificate of title over to the Buyer and complete any required state transfer form at the time of sale. Where the Trailer is not titled, either because it falls below the weight threshold for titling in [STATE] or because the title has been lost, the Seller confirms that here and provides the following available evidence of ownership instead: [MSO / PRIOR BILL OF SALE /

REGISTRATION / WEIGHT SLIP / NONE]. For a homemade or shop-built trailer, the Seller will provide receipts for the major components and any state-assigned VIN documentation. The Buyer accepts responsibility for any state inspection, VIN assignment, or weight certification needed to register the Trailer.

6. 6. As-Is Sale and No Warranty

THE TRAILER IS SOLD "AS IS, WHERE IS," WITH ALL FAULTS AND WITHOUT ANY WARRANTY, EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, INCLUDING NO WARRANTY OF MERCHANTABILITY AND NO WARRANTY OF FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE. The Buyer has inspected the Trailer, or has had the opportunity to inspect it, including the frame, welds, floor, axles, bearings, brakes, tires, lights, and coupler, and accepts it in its present condition. The Seller makes no representation that the Trailer meets any state inspection standard, is roadworthy, or is suitable for the load the Buyer intends to carry, and makes no representation about the accuracy of any weight rating plate that may be missing or illegible. The Seller is not responsible for any failure, tire blowout, bearing failure, or defect discovered after the transfer date. This provision does not excuse intentional misrepresentation about known frame damage or accident history.

7. 7. Transfer, Towing, and Release of Liability

Ownership and all risk of loss pass to the Buyer on [TRANSFER DATE] at [TRANSFER TIME], when possession of the Trailer is delivered at [DELIVERY LOCATION]. The Buyer is responsible for towing or transporting the Trailer from that location and confirms having an adequate tow vehicle, hitch, safety chains, functioning lights, and any brake controller required for the axle configuration described in Section 3. The Buyer is responsible for insurance covering the Trailer and its contents from the transfer date. The Seller will remove the license plate unless state law requires it to remain with the Trailer, and will file any notice of transfer or release of liability required in [STATE] within [RELEASE FILING PERIOD, e.g., five days]. The Buyer is solely responsible for any citation, toll, or incident occurring after the transfer date and will indemnify the Seller against any such claim.

8. 8. Governing Law, Entire Agreement, and Signatures

This Bill of Sale is governed by the laws of the State of [GOVERNING STATE], with venue in the courts located in [COUNTY AND STATE]. It is the entire agreement between the parties about the Trailer and replaces any listing, advertisement, or verbal statement made before signing; any change must be in writing and signed by both parties. 9. Disclaimer

This template is provided for general informational purposes only and is not legal advice. Trailer titling and registration rules vary widely by state: some states title all trailers, others only those above a weight threshold, and homemade trailers usually require an inspection and a state-assigned VIN before they can be registered. Notarization is required in a few states. Towing requirements, including brake and license class rules, are also set by state law.
